Ephesians 3:10, 21 ...¹⁰so that through the church the manifold wisdom of God might now be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly places. ...²¹ to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever.

The Mission of the Church has 3 parts:

- 1. To make disciples
- 2. To serve God
- 3. To bring glory to God

Ephesians 4:32 Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.

Romans 12:9-10 Let love be genuine. Abhor what is evil; hold fast to what is good. Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honor.

Matthew 18:15-17 "If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault, between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have gained your brother. But if he does not listen, take one or two others along with you, that every charge may be established by the evidence of two or three witnesses. If he refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church. If he refuses to

listen even to the church, let him be to you as a Gentile and a tax collector."

John 14:15-17 "If you love me, you will keep my commandments. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, even the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you."

(See also John 14:25-26 and John 16:7-8).

1 Corinthians 12:18-23 But as it is, God arranged the members in the body, each one of them, as he chose. If all were a single member, where would the body be? As it is, there are many parts, yet one body. The eye cannot say to the hand, "I have no need of you," nor again the head to the feet, "I have no need of you." On the contrary, the parts of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable, and on those parts of the body that we think less honorable we bestow the greater honor, and unpresentable parts are treated with greater modesty.
